EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2020

Dear EWUF Members and Associates,

Good news we have been informed by the 2020 European Wushu Championships Organising Committee that the government authorities in Moscow have confirmed international sports events can now be held there.

The 2020 European Wushu Championship Organising Committee confirm that if the situation remains stable they will run our championship estimated starting competition on 22 October 2020. Judges courses will be held before the competition begins.

It is planned to also hold seminars, workshops and grading assessments during the event.

The Organising Committee will send out fuller details in due course with exact dates.

If the event goes ahead, we shall have our congress. Once details of the schedule for the event is finalised we shall inform you of the date and time of the congress.

We must make it perfectly clear that if the Russian authorities change their rules regarding the COVID-19 situation we may have to postpone the event again. We shall keep contact with the organisers and advise accordingly.

We know that many of our members want us to host our championship this year, but we shall be guided by medical advice. It is understandable that some may not wish to travel during this difficult period, we understand this and shall respect individual decisions on participation (if it goes ahead).
